Marquette County EMS for Saving Our Lives!

The Village Board believes that a station in the Village should be one of the 3 stations located within Marquette County for the following reasons:

- ✓ Westfield is the 2nd largest community in the county with a population of 1250.
- ✓ We are a growing community within Marquette County. There are plans for businesses in a new strip mall near the highway interchange and a multi-unit housing development is in the works; we are seeing an increase in residential building permits as well.
- ✓ Westfield has the busiest interchange in the county.
- ✓ Westfield is home to a School District responsible for many grade school and high school students during the school day, after hours and for extra-curricular activities.
- ✓ There are 3 major Church camps in our area and they are responsible for large numbers of youth and adults during the summer months.
- ✓ The surrounding townships benefit from many people with 2nd homes and vacation cottages. They contribute to the tax base and are a secondary population figure throughout the year, particularly during the summer months.
- ✓ Adding in the townships, a Westfield location represents 30% of the county and minimum 30% of the EMS calls.

The Village Board has offered the following incentives to the EMS:

- ✓ A zoned lot in our Industrial Park which will be shovel-ready for construction.
- ✓ All sewer hookups to be available and sewer fees waived for 5 years; electrical main to the building and meter; a paved driveway approach and a secondary emergency only access.
- ✓ A well is also offered up to \$10,000.
